

RoHS Declaration of Conformity

Directive 2011/65/EU (previously 2002/95/EG) of the European Union on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS) became operative as from the 3rd of January 2013 (previously 1st of July, 2006).

Following substances namely are involved:

Lead (Pb)
Cadmium (Cd)
Hexavalent Chromium (Cr^{VI})
Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)
Polybrominated Diphenyl ethers (PBDE)
Mercury (Hg)

An amendment to the RoHS Directive[(EU) 2015/863] was published in the EU Official Journal of 4 June 2015. Thus Annex II of the RoHS Directive is extended by the following four substances:

Butylbenzylphthalat (BBP)
Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalat (DEHP)
Dibutylphthalat (DBP)
Diisobutylphthalat (DIBP)

The VTI Ventil Technik GmbH herewith declares, all of our products will be manufactured RoHS conformal. Some of the metal parts are machined on different machines. To increase the machinability, these copper alloys contain up to 4,0 % Pb in acceptance to RoHS. (see RoHS Annex III , point 6c)
